The Covid Stuff

We are certified with <u>We're Good To Go</u>" managed and run by Visit Britain (National Tourism Agency) which means that we have put in place the correct government measures in regards to cleaning and managing our campsite arrivals, limiting the number of guests here at any one time and reducing contact..

Finchingfield Camping responsibilities

Your responsibilities

- Respect and adhere to social distancing measures during your stay and keep 2 metres apart where possible and 1 metre at the very least

- Wash your hands with Alco-gel before and after use of shared facilities
- Use cleaning products provided to spray and wipe down taps and handles after use of any shared facility showers and taps
- Do not travel if you or any of your household show symptoms of Covid -19
- Have fun, enjoy the site, the views and our local village



Your Arrival

Check-in is between 15:00 - 20:00 **Check-out** is by 11:00 You are on holiday so the last thing we want to do is to give you a timetable. Confirm your arrival time by text or whatsapp - **Julia 07871254626.**

Vehicles and Parking

Parking is located close to the entrance where you will also find our nifty <u>Dura-Carts</u> for transporting your stuff down to your pitch. Some pitches are a 5 min walk away. Our Dura-Carts are lightweight and can effortlessly carry lots of bags, two kids and up to 140 kilos of stuff.

Pitches

All of our pitches have lovely views, sunshine and the same facilities – fire pit with a picnic bench and a cast iron grill so that you can use BBQ coals or wood to cook your food over. Picnic benches do have a hole for an umbrella so if you can squeeze it in the car then bring it along.

Fire Pits

Each pitch has a 60cm or 80cm fire pit or a Chimenea. The fire pits have a cast iron grill on top that can be used as a BBQ. If you bring your own BBQ you can place it on the firepit or on the grass as long as it has legs and is not too close to the ground as the grass can get very dry. All fire pits and BBQ's must be extinguished before you go to bed for fire safety. They are also in a set location and can't be moved as the grass is extremely dry. Tents must be 2m's away from fire pits.







The Shed

Fridge - It's not possible for us to operate the use of the fridge under the current guidelines. Therefore have a freezer in place to be used for your ice packs only and stored at your own risk.

Charging - USB charging station available. Please bring your own leads.

Firewood – We have to stay cashless. Purchase firewood in advance or while you are here with cash or a bank transfer.

Notice board – this is located outside on the side of the showers and includes safety info, location grid refs, Greener Camping Club campsite rules and local attraction info.

Showers

We have two showers on site. They are eco-friendly LPG gas run with no electricity. The showers will be deep cleaned daily and cleaning products are provided for you to use before and after use.

Toilets

You have your own private composting toilet located on your pitch. You will be given instructions on how to use the toilet. If used correctly they will not smell at all. Cleaning products and loo roll are provided.

Recycling

Together we are trying to achieve sustainable low impact camping holidays. Please help and do your bit by recycling while you are here.

- Food waste
- Mixed Recycling soft plastic food wrapping and cartons, cardboard, paper, cans

- glass recycling

Drinking Water and washing up

We have one large sink by the showers and toilets which is drinking water. At the moment the sink is only to be used for washing up and not personal hygiene, so clean your teeth in the shower - easy as that.

Another drinking water tap is also located up by The Shed close to the carpark. You must wipe down the tap and use alcohol gel on your hands before use. We recommend bringing a water carrier to limit the number of times that you use the shared taps.
